### SUMMER INTERN

Are you looking for something different for a summer job, have an interest in protecting the regions drinking water supply and like working outside? If so, we want to hear from you; Today.

The Boothbay Region Water District is looking for a special individual to fill our summer intern position. This is a full-time (40 hours per week) position from May/June to September/October. The summer intern will be primarily assigned to the Natural Resources Division and Distribution Division at the water district where the individual will be expected to assist in a variety of natural resource program tasks including, lake and stream water sampling, laboratory analyses, invasive plant mapping, assessment, and removal, ditch and stormwater infrastructure maintenance, site monitoring and documentation using GIS, and may be required to conduct a door-to-door survey of shorefront property owners on Knickerbocker Lake. The intern will also be expected to assist the Distribution Division with a variety of tasks and may be called upon at times to assist the Treatment Division.

The intern must be able to follow detailed instructions, be able to engage in physical labor for several hours at a time. Work in small boats will be required, as will a valid driver's license with a clean driving record. This job will require outdoor work in a variety of conditions and may at times be strenuous. The individual must be able to work independently and as part of a team. Written and verbal communication skills are a must.
